- 1821 Small & Wagner York and Adams County map (reproduction available in Museum Shop)
 - Lists churches and mills
- 1850 Moody York Boro map (reproduction available in Museum Shop)
 - Lists property owners, churches and other public buildings in York
- 1860 Lake and Shearer map of York County (reproduction available in Museum Shop)
 - large canvas wall map that lists each property owner as well as mills, schools and railroads
- 1870 Hopkins map of York City
- 1876 Atlas of York County (reproduction available in Museum Shop)
 - book of township maps listing each property owner as well as mills, schools and railroads
- 1895 York County map (reproduction available in Museum Shop)
 - Shows communities, post offices and railroads
- 1915 Farm Journal of York County with accompanying map
- 1976 Atlas and Plat Book – York County, PA sponsored by York County 4-H council
